A reflection on Henry's contributions to CADS from Bernard Oigny, current CADS Board Member and President of CADS Quebec

- Foremost, he was an excellent and passionate CADS ski instructor;
- He was one of the original CADS pioneers;
- He was CADS president for over 11 years;
- In 1997 he received the Karl Hilzinger Life Time Award for his remarkable contribution to the development of ski for adaptive skiing in Canada
- He was twice chef of the Canadian winter paralympic delegation (Salt Lake City and Vancouver
- He was the pioneer and founder of CADS-Québec;
- He was CADS-Québec president for more than 19 years:
- He was the pioneer founder of the Richard Lemieux Foundation (1982; charity organisation 1987);
- He presided this Foundation till his death;
- He was the initiator/founder of the Tessier accreditation for CADS-Québec;
- He was for many years on the CPC board of directors and was also one of their past president;
